DON'T LEAVE MONEY ON THE TABLE

Here's how to file your taxes for free:

1. Online at MyFreeTaxes.com powered by H&R Block
2. On location at the sites listed to the right where computers and IRS certified volunteers will be available to answer your tax related questions while you prepare your tax return
3. Must have an email address and basic computer skills. We can help with the rest. No tax knowledge required. Don't worry, you can do this!

What to Bring:

Photo Identification

Social Security or Individual Taxpayer Identification

Number (ITIN) for each family member

Birth dates for each family member

Last year's federal and state returns, if you have them

Bank routing & account numbers to direct deposit refund

Childcare expenses, provider name, address & tax ID

W-2s, 1099s, 1098s and other forms of income

1095-A, B or C, Affordable Healthcare Statements

Health Insurance Exemption Certificate, if received

Heat Bill, Landlord Info and Property Tax Bills
